

Mr Yasuhito Kinoshita is a Professor of Sociology at Rikkyo University in Tokyo. He specializes in the Sociology of Ageing and Care, Welfare State, and Qualitative Research. In 1984, he obtained his PhD in Human Development and Ageing at the University of California, San Francisco. In 1999, Professor Kinoshita proposed the Modified Grounded Theory Approach (M-GTA) which was in response to a split in the early 1990s by the originators of the Theory by Glaser & Strauss (1967) approach while answering criticisms from Critical Qualitative Research. The M-GTA is now one of the most popular qualitative methods in Nursing, Social Work, Care, Health, Clinical Psychology/Counselling, School Education, Teaching Japanese Language, Business Management etc. in Japan. The Japanese Society of M-GTA, founded in 1999, now has a membership of over 500. Apart from his long list of publications on M-GTA, Professor Kinoshita has translated Glaser & Strauss "Awareness of Dying" book into Japanese and has been on the editorial board of "Qualitative Social Work: Research and Practice".
